

## SEMINAR L'MOROS BAIS YAAKOV

### CARES ACT GRANT REPORTING I

Seminar L' Moros Bais Yaakov has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Seminar L' Moros Bais Yaakov will receive or has received a total \$322,207 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Seminar L' Moros Bais Yaakov has disbursed \$132,000 to 132 students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of 6/22/2020

The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of 6/22/2020 is 488.

The method used by Seminar L' Moros Bais Yaakov to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive is based on the number of students enrolled, their course of study and enrollment status and on an estimated budget for expenses for food, course material, equipment needed to participate in the educational program due to the disruption of campus operations, travel home expenses and health care related expenses which has been calculated at up to \$1,000 for a full time student, and up to \$500 for a part time student.

Students received the following instructions with their grants: "As per the CARES Act, these grants are to be used for expenses that are related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19, including things like course materials and technology as well as food, housing, health care, and childcare."
